In March of 2020, Kids Alley, like so many others was facing unprecedented challenges. Quickly, we adapted to continue serving the children and families of Camden, NJ and the surrounding areas. We found new ways to connect with our clients during a time when everything was becoming distanced. From March through June our students received virtual academic support and tutoring. During the month of July, we successfully hosted a Summer Camp without even one case of COVID-19. We knew that our students needed in-person support and we were up to the challenge.

Once again as school districts began making decisions for the upcoming school year, we revised our playbook and adjusted our programs to better meet the needs of those we serve. At the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year, we expanded our services from an after-school homework and enrichment program to a full-day academic support program (page 5). By expanding our services from aftercare to full-day care, we provide security, stability, and normalcy to children and families in a time of historic turmoil.

The two main school districts that our organization serves embraced hybrid and remote learning formats. We recognize that these decisions will help to lessen the risks associated with COVID-19, but many students and parents are left with significant burdens. Students were concerned about learning with little to no personalized support and socialization. Parents were now struggling to find childcare. Lastly, many families were facing the reality of a learning language barrier. Many of our students go to schools that are taught in English and go home to households where the guardians primarily speak Spanish. This creates a unique challenge for students learning new material at home, especially if they need help or have questions. In line with our mission (page 5), we took a leap of faith and expanded our services during a time of uncertainty unlike anything our society has ever experienced.

The Kids Alley Learning Center existed as an after-school program committed to building strong hearts, strong minds, and strong bodies until September of 2020. At the suggestion of the superintendent of one of the schools we serve and in response to the unique needs created by COVID-19, we became a full-day program. We continue to offer the essential in-person academic support that many of our students need. We provide transportation to the Learning Center from a nearby school location and return them to a stop near their home. The students receive nutritious snacks and meals are provided to those who did not bring their own. Students are expected to diligently work and complete their classwork from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm, following their school's online curriculum. Our talented staff of teachers, retired teachers, and qualified aides assist students as needed. After spending hours engaged in online learning and classwork, students take a well-deserved lunch break. Following lunch, students spend the remainder of the afternoon enjoying free time, engaging in enriching activities, and learning during a time set aside for character building devotionals. Without our full-day learning center, many of these students would not have the support necessary to thrive while taking part in remote learning.
